Complaint Summary	Complainant is residing in Germany. Complainant applied for a postal vote in the recent federal election. Complainant received postal ballot but found the Senate ballot had been filled in. Complainant claims she has lost her right to vote.

Terms of Settlement	Complainant satisfied with response

Complaint Summary	Complainant is from Iraq and is currently in Australia on a Temporary Protection Visa. Complainant claims prior to the granting of a Temporary Protection Visa he was in detention and separation detention for four months. Complainant claims conditions of detention were very harsh and he was treated 'like an animal'. Complainant claims his legs were broken during a demonstration and he was imprisoned for eight months. Complainant claims his wife and three daughters followed him to Australia two years later. Complainant claims his wife's boat was stopped at Darwin and redirected to the excised territory. Complainant's family was in Christmas Island and have now been moved to Papua New Guinea. Complainant first heard of his family's fate in February 2002.
