If this makes you feel **uncomfortable** or **unsafe**, it could be **workplace sexual harassment**.

Are you **scared** to say something because **you're worried about your temporary visa, keeping your job** or getting a **good reference**?

If this kind of behaviour makes you **feel unsafe**, it could be **workplace sexual harassment**.

Workplace sexual harassment is **against the law**.

A customer

Your boss

A patient

Your colleague

A contractor

It's **your boss's job** to take steps to make sure **you are safe at work**.
