
IncludeAbility

What is IncludeAbility?



The IncludeAbility project has **four** parts.



1 The IncludeAbility Employer Network

This is a group of organisations who want to make good jobs for people with disability.



2 An Ambassador Advisory Group

This is a group of people with disability.

They give advice to the employer network organisations about the needs of people with disability.



3 The IncludeAbility website

This is a website that includes information for

- people with disability who want a good job
- organisations who employ people with a disability



4 Pilot Programs

The IncludeAbility team and network organisations will create some employment programs together.

These programs will look at new ways of creating good jobs for people with disability.
