The Commission's Understanding workplace sexual harassment eLearning course is informed by our recent *Respect@Work: National Inquiry into Sexual Harassment in Australian Workplaces* report. This course aims to enhance participants' understanding of the **nature, drivers and impacts of workplace sexual harassment**.

This self-paced eLearning course takes 2-3 hours to complete.

- The nature and prevalence of workplace sexual harassment in Australian workplaces
- The rights and responsibilities of workers and employers in relation to workplace sexual harassment
- The causes and contributors to workplace sexual harassment
- The impacts workplace sexual harassment may have on individuals and workplaces.
